


3. MOU can be ongoing till it is specifically terminated with mutual agreement, by both the parties, presented in writing.

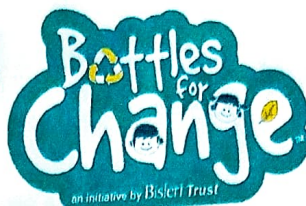


